Attached are some photos of a visit from Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Development Disabilities, Kevin Tanner, in support of our gardening projects at Georgia Regional Hospital. The commissioner gave us three citrus trees (yuzu lemons) from Georgia Grown Citrus.

Also pictured below is the spring garden before we have planted (except sweet potato plants and spinach seeds). You can see our small winter crop of lettuce, chard, kale, radishes. We let some of the radishes go to seed so we can harvest and replant. Heavily featured is the mint which is happy to take over! Strawberries, blueberries, and blackberries are ripening. Yesterday, we planted a row of sweet

potato plants in a back corner. We traded some of the sweet potato plants we cultivated for okra and spinach seeds from a staff member who has a garden. On Tuesday during Group, we planted a short row of spinach seeds, and we are starting other spinach seeds indoors.
